2022 LHS FILM FESTIVAL







2022 JIM FERNALD IB SCHOLARSHIP

Jim Fernald was born November 27, 1956 in Washington, DC, the only child of Art and Jean Fernald. They moved to Lakewood, Colorado in 1965.

Mr. Fernald graduated from Lakewood High School in 1975. He received a math degree from Northwestern University in 1979 and a math education degree from the University of Minnesota 1982. He received a master's degree in Education at the University of Colorado at Denver in 1992.

He taught math in Aurora Public Schools, mostly at Rangeview High School from 1982 - 2004. He finished his teaching career at his alma mater, Lakewood High School, teaching math and Theory of Knowledge from 2004 - 2014. After retirement, he still substituted at Lakewood High and attended many school events. His favorite job was helping to plan graduation activities.

Mr. Fernald passed away in 2020. His support for Lakewood High School graduates continues through his bequeath and the generosity of the Lakewood Foundation.
